The father of our faith established his covenant with God there, the redeemer of mankind was crucified there and an empty tomb testifies of this precious faith that was once delivered unto the saints. Join with us in this anointed, tangible, walk-through experience, as we travel through the Holy Land together.

DAY 1 DEPART USA TO TEL AVIV

Today we depart from the USA and fly to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

DAY 2 ARRIVE IN TEL AVIV, ISRAEL

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to our hotel in Tiberius for check in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

DAY 3 CAESAREA / MT. CARMEL / MEGIDDO / NAZARETH VILLAGE / CANA / TIBERIUS

This morning we travel to Caesarea by the Sea on the Mediterranean coastline. It was here that Cornelius the Centurion and his household were saved and baptized (Acts 10), and it was also where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome (Acts 25 & 26). See the top of Mt. Carmel, where Elijah prayed down the fire from Heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). Visit Megiddo and the Valley of Armageddon (Revelation 16). From here we can also see Mt. Gilboa where King Saul and his sons lost their lives against the Philistines (I Samuel 28) and Mt. Tabor where Barak awaited Sisera (Judges 4), and which is the traditional site of the transfiguration (Matthew 17). Pass through Cana where Christ performed His first miracle (John 2) and Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus (Luke 2). Stop at Nazareth Village, where we can get a sense of what a First Century Jewish village would look like. Return to Tiberius for dinner and overnight.

DAY 4 SEA OF GALILEE / CAPERNAUM / MT. OF BEATITUDES / GADERA / BOAT RIDE / JORDAN RIVER

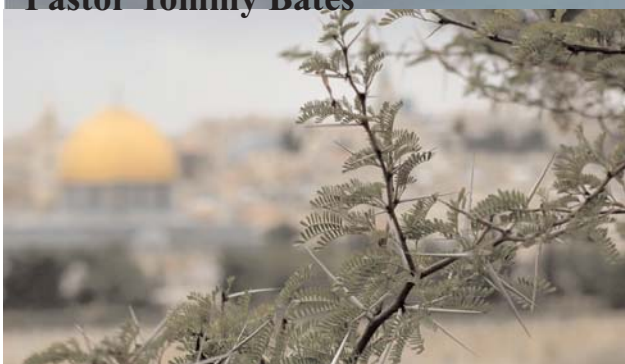
After enjoying the Israeli buffet breakfast, we will spend most of our day around the Sea of Galilee. Drive along the shores of the lake, passing the area of Magdala, home of Mary Magdalene. Enter the 2,000-year-old remains of Capernaum (Luke 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5- 7). Journey through the land of the Gadarenes, where Jesus cast the demons into swine (Mark 5). After a delicious fish lunch, enjoy a beautiful boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Remember the baptism of Jesus at the Jordan River, before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 5 GOLAN HEIGHTS / MT. HERMON / CAESAREA PHILIPPI / TEL DAN

Journey today through the Golan Heights and gain a greater understanding of the importance of this region to the security of Israel. See Mount Hermon, marking the northern border of ancient Israel (Joshua 11). Walk the path to Baniyas, ancient Caesarea Philippi, where Peter exclaimed, “You are the Christ” (Matthew 16). Visit Tel Dan, whose layers of history have been excavated. Return to Tiberius and our final night on the Sea of Galilee. Tomorrow we journey to Jerusalem.

DAY 6 GIDEON'S SPRING (HAROD) / BET SHEAN / JORDAN VALLEY / QUMRAN / VALLEY OF THE SHADOW / JERUSALEM

Today we begin our journey south to Jerusalem. Stop at Harod and Gideon's Spring, where God chose his army of 300 to face the Midianites (Judges 7). As our motor coach takes us through the Jordan Valley, we will visit the tel of Bet Shean where the bodies of King Saul and his sons hung from the city gates (I Samuel 31). Parallel the Jordan River all the way to Qumran, a settlement dating back to the First Century BC. Near here the Dead Sea Scrolls were uncovered. Journey “up” through the Valley of the



Shadow, thought to have inspired David as he wrote the 23rd Psalm. Look out over Jerusalem before checking into our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 7 BETHLEHEM / SHEPHERD'S FIELD / MT. OF OLIVES / PALM SUNDAY ROAD / GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE / MT. ZION / UPPER ROOM / WESTERN WALL / POOLS OF BETHESDA / ST ANNE'S CHURCH

This morning we will cross over into Bethlehem, the birthplace of our Lord (Luke 2). Look out over the Shepherd's Fields, where the angels brought the Good News. After a time of sightseeing and shopping we will return to Jerusalem see olive trees on the Mount of Olives (Luke 19 & II Samuel 15) that date back to the time of Christ. Walk down the Palm Sunday Road toward the Garden of Gethsemane (John 18), where Jesus prayed. Look out over the City of David from Mount Zion. Remember the Last Supper and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the Upper Room (Luke 22, Acts 2). We will take time to pray at the Western Wall. Look over the ruins that once were built over the Pools of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the infirm man (John 5). Lift our voice in song and praise in St. Anne's Church and enjoy the wonderful acoustics. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 MASADA / EIN GEDI / DEAD SEA

Journey south to the Dead Sea and the mountain fortress of Masada. Erected by Herod, Masada became famous as the last hold out against the Romans in the Jewish revolt. We can still see the outlines of the Roman siege forts that surrounded Masada below. Visit the Oasis of Ein Gedi, where David hid from Saul (I Samuel 23). Then feel the mineral laden waters of the Dead Sea, famous for its buoyancy. Return through the Judean wilderness past Bedouin camps to Jerusalem.

DAY 9 MODEL CITY / SHRINE OF THE BOOK / YAD VASHEM (HOLOCAUST MUSEUM) / TEMPLE MOUNT / GARDEN TOMB / GORDON'S CALVARY

Begin our day at the outstanding Model of Jerusalem as it was during the Roman occupation that will help us understand what the city looked like during the time of Christ. Walk the halls of the Shrine of the Book Museum, home to some of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Wander Yad Vashem (Holocaust Museum) and renew our understanding of this event with the purpose of knowing that we must never let this happen, again. Cross the Temple Mount where both the First and Second Temples once stood. Sense the agony of Christ's crucifixion at Gordon's Calvary (Luke 23) and experience the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb. After a final dinner, prepare to return to the United States.

DAY 10 ARRIVE IN USA

Today we arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish.

YOUR ACCOMMODATIONS will be in first class and/or deluxe hotels. If you do not have a roommate and NTS is unable to arrange one, you must pay a supplemental room charge of \$500. All single rooms are subject to availability and may be smaller than normal twin rooms.

YOUR LUGGAGE (one suitcase) will be handled for you upon arrival overseas (after you clear customs), transferred between hotels, piers, etc. Your carry-on will be your own responsibility.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of \$300 per person is required. Final payment for the trip, including travel protection premium, is due **JULY 31, 2009**. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100.00 or more will be assessed, depending on the date payment is received.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: 1) Optional Travel Protection Program; 2) Miscellaneous fees such as individual Transfers; Passports, Laundry, Beverages at Meals; Excess Baggage and Items of a Personal Nature; 3) NOTE: Non US Citizens must obtain any VISA's required for entry. 4) Love Offering for Guide and Driver; 5) Fuel surcharges which may be imposed by airlines and other suppliers. If applicable, fuel surcharge will be paid by the passenger.

CHANGES: When a written request to change the standard program is approved by NTS, a minimum of \$80 per person, per change will be charged. Transfers for such passengers are not included in the program price and are solely the responsibility of the passenger.

CANCELLATION FEES: 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable.
